- The upper floors are completely occupied and the NCC building is running at a level that is self-sustaining.
- Played a leading role in the adoption of the Community Preservation Act, which will provide much-needed support for many worthy projects.
- Helped support grant applications by the Life Saving Station and Open Space Committees.
- Held a second very successful Annual Gala Evening, honoring the extraordinary work of the Life Saving Station Committee and the Historical Society.

Looking forward —

- We continue to actively support the preservation efforts of the **Nahant Life Saving Station Committee** and expect to take a more active role in the rehabilitation and re-use of that iconic building.
- We are working with the **Nahant Open Space Committee** to develop walking paths, and participate in the Heritage Landscape Program.
- We have been asked to be the stewards of a parcel of land, now buildable, to hold and preserve the parcel in its natural open state in perpetuity. We hope this is but the first of many such opportunities to preserve by outright gift or conservation restriction many of the estate properties in Town that are now endangered.

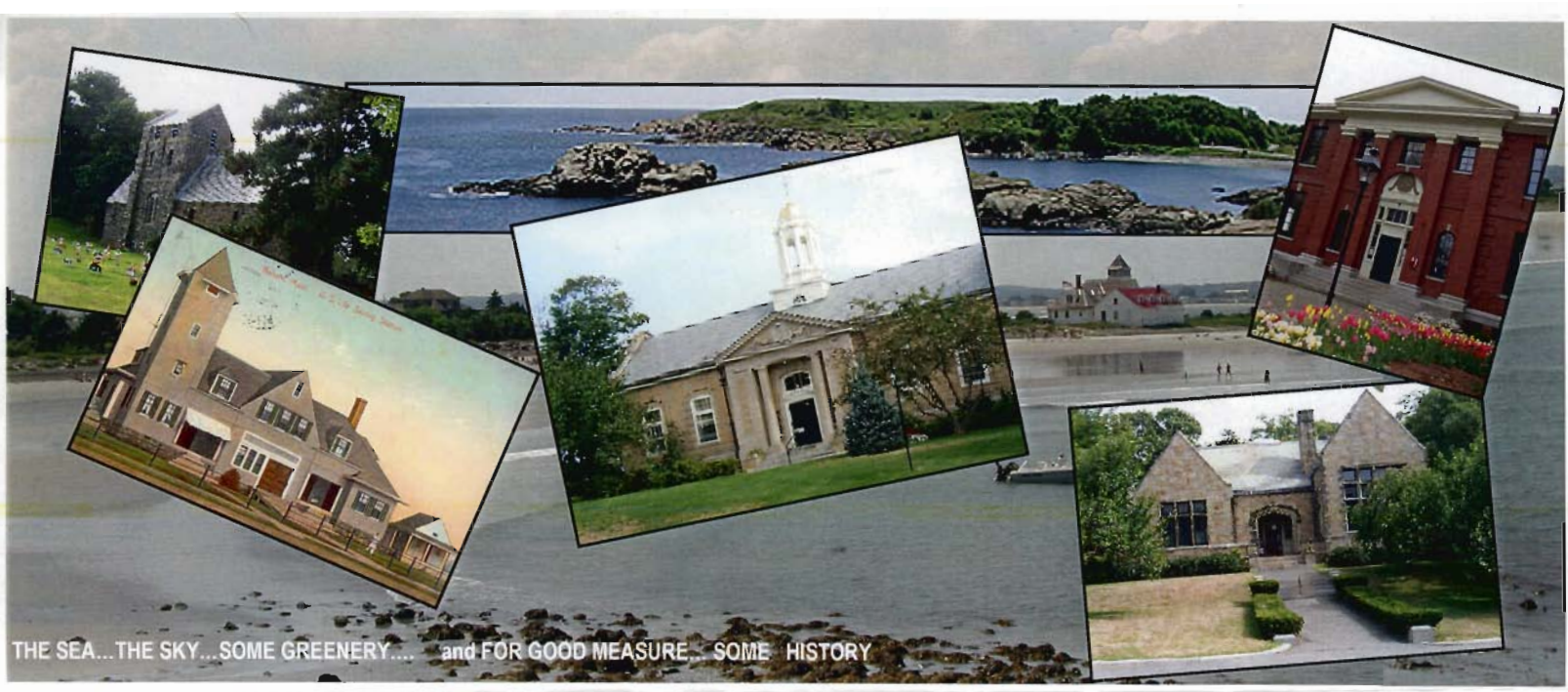

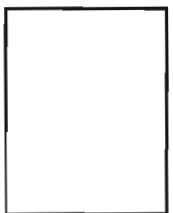
